



2019 Children's Development Program Lottery

In the past, we have set a registration date for seasonal programs on or near August 1. Places in the programs were then offered on a first come first served basis. With the increased popularity of our programs and the speed with which they have sold out, this format has begun to make the registration process more difficult and stressful than we would like. In order to alleviate this, we will use a two-week admission session again, making it smoother, easier, and simpler for you.

Part One: Registration

The lottery entry will be a two-week period, August 1 until the end of the day on August 15. During this period you will be invited to enter for D-Squad, Mountain Division, and / or Yeti Club. In order to register, you will be asked to commit to one or more programs and pay in full for your first choice.

- 1) Using the Express Line (our online shopping tool) you will select the program (based on days/number of sessions) that is your first choice.
- 2) After selecting the product, you will be asked to indicate a second and third choice program.
- 3) Complete the required forms and pay online to complete your registration.

Registration is a binding commitment to participate in whichever of your top three choice programs you are offered. Participants offered a spot in any of their top three choices will not receive a refund for any reason. Offers to join a program are non-transferrable. You are not obligated to select a second or third choice program. Whether or not you indicate a second or third choice will not influence the likelihood of being offered your first choice.

About the Programs

D SQUAD

- Race development program for advanced skiers only (level 6-8)
- Ages 7-13 (Birth Years 2005-2011)
- Fourteen 4.5 hour sessions, Saturdays & Sundays 9:30 am - 2 pm (includes 1/2 hour lunch) January 5 - March 3

The Mohawk Mountain Development Squad is a race program designed to give athletes the opportunity to build on the fundamental skills of skiing. The season will culminate with a home race towards the end of the regular program.

All new participants must pass Chairlift Rookie Training prior to program commencement. This involves D-Squad participants taking the Arrowhead Chair and pulling down the bar independently. Visit the Snowsports Desk to schedule Rookie training.

In addition, all NEW skiers in D Squad will be assessed on the first weekend of the program. This is to verify that they possess the advanced skiing skills necessary for success in the program.



Mountain Division is an action-packed 7 week program dedicated to developing and improving the skills of skiers. Squads average 7-8 members of similar ages and abilities, and are led by the same squad leader from week to week.

- 4.5 hour sessions, including 1/2 hour lunch
- Program fees include a junior anytime season pass

All new Mountain Division participants must pass Chairlift Rookie Training prior to program commencement. This involves taking the Deer Run (Pine) Chair and pulling down the bar independently.

If you are offered a spot in a program that does not cost the same as your first choice program, you will either have the balance refunded to you on a Mohawk Money card or be asked to pay the remaining balance within 10 days.
