Part One Registration

The lottery entry will be a two-week period, September 1st until the end of the day on September 15th. During this period you will be invited to enter for Interclub, D-Squad, Mountain Division, Hawk Stars and or Yeti Club. In order to register, you will be asked to commit to one or more programs and pay in full for your first choice.

- 1 Register on mohawkmtn.com to purchase the program (based on days/number of sessions) that is your first choice.
- 2 After selecting the product, you will be asked to indicate a second and third choice program.
- 3 Complete the required forms and pay online to complete your registration.

Registration is a binding commitment to participate in whichever of your top three choice programs you are placed. Participants placed in any of their top three choices will not receive a refund for any reason. Places in a program are non-transferrable. You are not obligated to select a second or third choice program. Whether or not you indicate a second or third choice will not influence the likelihood of being placed in your first choice.

About The Programs



Mohawk Mountain Interclub is a competitive alpine race program. Excellent coaching will be provided for athletes to hone their Giant Slalom skills and be introduced to the foundations of skiing Slalom. This is an exciting opportunity that will provide athletes with a fun racing experience in a competitive environment!

- Competitive Race program for advanced skiers only (level 7-8)
- Ages 8 to 13 (Birth Years 2009 to 2014)
- Fourteen 3 hour sessions, Saturdays & Sundays 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM January 7th – March 5th
- Coaching at approximately 3 away races in Massachusetts
- Program fees include a Jr. Anytime Season Pass

All new participants that have not previously taken part in D-Squad must pass Chairlift Rookie Training prior to program commencement. This involves Interclub participants taking the Arrowhead Chair and pulling down the bar independently. Call the Snowsports Desk to schedule Rookie training.

In addition, all NEW skiers in Interclub will be assessed on the first weekend of the program. This is to verify that they possess the advanced skiing skills necessary for success in the program.

PROGRAM COST \$1,949



Mountain Division is an action-packed 7 week program dedicated to developing and improving the skills of skiers. Squads average 7-8 members of similar ages and abilities, and are led by the same squad leader from week to week.

- Skill development program for skiers
- Intermediate to advanced skiers (Level 5-8)
- Ages 6-13 (Birth Years 2009-2016)
- 3 hour sessions for 14 sessions (Sat & Sun) or 7 sessions (SAT AM, SAT PM, SUN AM)
- Program fees include a junior anytime season pass

All new Mountain Division participants must pass Chairlift Rookie Training prior to program commencement. This involves taking the Deer Run (Pine) Chair and pulling down the bar independently.

We will accommodate as many participants as possible, but should you not receive a place in any of your chosen programs, we will provide you with a full refund of your purchase price to your original payment method. There will be no wait list - the lottery results announced on September 23rd will be final.

If you are placed in a program that does not cost the same as your first choice program, you will either have the balance refunded to you on a Mohawk Money card or be asked to pay the remaining balance within 10 days.
