

# CHILDREN'S DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM LOTTERY

## Part One Registration

September 8th - September 22nd  
Register Online

The lottery entry will be a two-week period, September 8th - September 22nd. During this period you will have the opportunity to register for Interclub, D-Squad, Mountain Division, Hawk Stars and/or Yeti Club. In order to register, you will be asked to commit to one or more programs and enter your card information as if you are purchasing the program. You will not be charged until October 10th, 2025, if accepted.

- Register an account if you do not already have one on [shop.mohawkmtn.com](http://shop.mohawkmtn.com) to select your preferred program (based on days/number of sessions) that is your first choice (there will be a program selection option)
- After selecting the product, you will be asked to select party member (participant - this is a drop down menu- as the account holder's name will appear as well)
- Add new party member (participant) and click continue
- Enter the participant information - birth dates MUST BE ACCURATE!  
If the parameters are correct you will click "add to cart" and follow all other instructions
- You can put multiple people into the shopping cart as one purchase
- Complete the required forms. Your credit card will not be charged unless you are accepted into the lottery. All charges will be completed on October 10th, 2025

Registration is a binding commitment to participate in whichever of your top three choice programs you are placed. Participants placed in any of their top three choices will not receive a refund for any reason. Places in a program are non-transferrable. You are not obligated to select a second or third choice program. Whether or not you include a second or third choice will not increase the likelihood of being placed in your first choice. The timing of registration does not impact the placement in a program.

## About The Programs



Mohawk Mountain Interclub is a competitive alpine race program. Seasoned coaches will provide athletes the guidance to hone their Giant Slalom skills and be introduced to the foundations of skiing Slalom. This is an exciting opportunity that will provide athletes with a fun racing experience in a competitive environment!

- Competitive race program for advanced skiers only (level 7-8)
- Ages 8-13 (birth years 2012 to 2017)
- Fourteen 5 hour sessions, Saturdays & Sundays 8:30 AM to 1:00 PM January 3<sup>rd</sup> - March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026
- No sessions on Jan. 17/18 & Feb. 14/15
- Coaching at approximately 3 away races in Massachusetts
- Lunch break during program, food not included in fee
- Program fees include a Junior Anytime Season Pass
- All new participants who have not previously taken part in D-Squad must pass Chairlift Rookie Training prior to program commencement. This involves Interclub participants taking Arrowhead Chair and pulling down the bar independently. Call the Snowsports desk to schedule Rookie Training.

In addition, all NEW skiers in Interclub will be assessed on the first weekend of the program. This is to verify they possess the advanced skiing skills necessary for success in the program.

PROGRAM COST \$2,199



Mountain Division is an action-packed 7 week program dedicated to developing and improving the skills of skiers. Squads average 7-8 members of similar ages and abilities, and are led by the seasoned instructors from week to week.

- Ages 6-13 (birth years 2012-2019)
- 3 hour sessions for 14 sessions (Sat & Sun) or 7 sessions (Sat AM, Sat PM, Sun AM)
- No sessions on Jan. 17/18 & Feb 14/15
- Program fees include a Jr. Anytime Season Pass

All new Mountain Division participants must pass Chairlift Rookie Training prior to program commencement. This involves D-Squad participants taking Deer Run (Pine) Chair or Mohawk Chair and pulling down the bar independently. Call the Snowsports desk to schedule Rookie Training.

- Program fees include a Junior Anytime Season Pass
